

## **KLINGER ADDITION ALLOWS APC TO DOUBLE MICROWAVE POP CORN PRODUCTION**

W.A. Klinger was awarded the work to complete a 27,000 SF addition to the American Pop Corn (APC) campus in Sioux City. Klinger was the general contractor as well as a design consultant for the project. The work was performed on a fast track basis and the project was completed on time and on budget.

All tie-ins to the existing microwave plant required detailed coordination since it remained operational during construction of the addition. Close attention to the unique requirements of construction in a food processing environment was also critical while building this all-precast structure.



The new addition allows the company to double the number of production lines that make and package Jolly Time microwave popcorn. Along with the new addition, the microwave plant now totals 42,750 SF.

APC is a global leader in microwave and other popcorn products. A recent endorsement by Weight Watchers of Jolly Time Healthy Pop and other healthy products resulted in a sharp spike in demand for their products, making the new addition necessary and possible.

APC began operations in Sioux City in 1914 and spans five generations in the Siouxland community. It sells products in all 50 states and 45 countries.
